

Hanging Guidelines for Scholarship Show

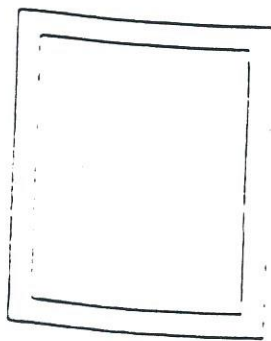
Two-Dimensional Work

1. All work must be matted. Use heavy mat board, white or neutral is recommended.
2. Framing is optional. Lack of framing will not negatively effect the jurying of the work.
3. If not framed, work must be wrapped in acetate. Miter the corners and use clear packing tape. Do not laminate. Pastel or charcoal work should be sprayed and/or covered with acetate.
4. Attach hanging wire. Cut two 2" x 3" pieces of mat board and punch a hole in the pieces. Wrap wire around holes three times. Glue mat pieces 1/3 down to the back of art work. Secure well. Entry labels are attached to the back upper right corner of each piece.
5. There are a certain amount of small table easels for smaller works that can be presented on the round tables.

Three- Dimensional Work

1. Hanging relief sculpture must have secure attached hanging wire.
2. Labels must be attached to back or bottom of work. You may reduce the size of tag for smaller works.

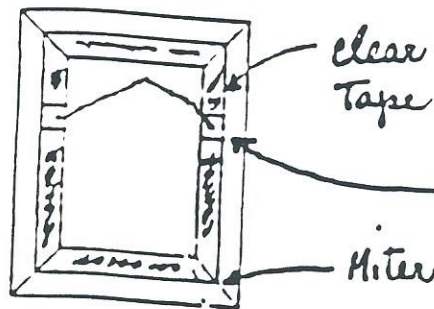
