FRIESEKE (OLLECTION GREW IN 2024

2024 was a banner year celebrating Frederick C. Frieseke's 150th birthday (1874-1939) with a special event held on his April 7th birthday, two wonderful paintings gifted to SAC's Frieseke Gallery and two outdoor signboards installed in Curwood Castle Park promoting his life and work.



A lovely 1920 painting, *Dressing*, oil on canvas, was generously donated by Cherie & Harlow Murray (pictured) last October. It is given in loving memory of her parents and former Owosso residents, Charles and Esther Sanders. The painting has an excellent provenance, descended directly from Frieseke's family (Kilmer) and is included in the Frieseke catalogue raisonne compiled by his grandson, Nicholas Kilmer. The Murrays, who live in Saginaw and recently became SAC board members, stated, "We believe Frieseke would be very pleased that this beautiful painting now resides in his hometown of Owosso."



In December, Hank & Liesel Meijer generously donated this impressive 1905-06 oil painting, *Afternoon Tea on the Terrace* to SAC's collection. Meijer representative, David Hooker and SAC Director, Piper Brewer (with SAC mascot, Jax) are standing next to the large five-by-five foot piece, which was part of a much larger mural Frieseke created for John Wanamaker's Hotel Shelbourne in Atlantic City. Hank Meijer stated, "I'm thrilled it's found a home with SAC."



The Shiawassee Distrist Library -Owosso, and Edwards Sign & Printing Company teamed up with SAC to create two doublesided Frieseke "ArtWalk" signs, which were installed near the Arts Center in Curwood Castle Park. Another Frieseke sign will be placed outside the library later this year.
